AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of increasing the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 24 from three to five members and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The number of commissioners in Fire Protection District No. 24 will decrease to three as of January 1, 1986 unless a ballot issue to the contrary is approved by district voters.

SECTION 2. Fire Protection District No. 24 by Resolution 85-12, has proposed increasing their Board of Fire Commissioners from three to five members, finding that the increase will allow the business of the fire district to be conducted in a more efficient manner and it is therefore in the best interest of the district to increase the number of commissioners from three to five.

SECTION 3. Resolution 85-12 of King County Fire Protection District No. 24 has been prepared in accordance with provisions of R.C.W. 52.14.015.

SECTION 4. A special election shall be held on the 17th day of September, 1985 within King County Fire Protection District No. 24. The ballot proposition shall be in substantially the following form in accordance with R.C.W. 52.14.015:

"Shall the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 24 be increased from three members to five members?"
