ORDINANCE NO. 7325

An ordinance relating to traffic control, prohibiting parking during school hours on the east side of 148th Avenue Southeast from Southeast Fairwood Boulevard to a point 800 feet north of Southeast Fairwood Boulevard, and amending King County Ordinance 5292, Schedule 15.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized by RCW 46.90, Schedule 15 of King County Ordinance 5292 which prohibits parking at certain times along county roads, is amended to add the following location:

148TH AVENUE SOUTHEAST, ON EAST SIDE, FROM SOUTHEAST FAIRWOOD BOULEVARD TO A POINT 800 FEET NORTH OF SOUTHEAST FAIRWOOD BOULEVARD.

SECTION 2: Signs posted to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.

SECTION 3: Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor, and the punishment shall be provided by the laws of the State of Washington.
