ORDINANCE NO. 7326

AN ORDINANCE relating to the women's advisory group, defining term of appointments and amending Ordinance No. 3631, Section 7 and K.C.C. 2.30.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3631, Section 7, as amended and K.C.C. 2.30.060 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

There is established a King County women's advisory group to be composed of eleven members, one nominated from each council district by the county council, and two nominated by the county executive. These nominations shall represent the diversity of women in King County and shall not include employees or board members of agencies receiving funding from the women's program. Nominees shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by a majority vote of the county council.

Once constituted, the women's advisory group shall establish terms of appointment by lot. Four members shall serve one year; four members shall serve two years; and three members shall serve three years.

After the initial terms have expired, all appointments shall be for a period of three years.
