

ORDINANCE NO. 7330

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election to determine whether Federal Way shall be incorporated as a noncharter code city; to elect officers under the plan of government proposed.

PREAMBLE:

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 35A.03 of the Revised Code of Washington, a petition for incorporation as a noncharter code city, signed by qualified voters resident within the limits of the proposed city equal in number to ten percent of the votes cast in the proposed area at the last preceding general state election has been presented to the records and elections division.

The petition for incorporation states that the form of government under which the proposed city will operate in the event it is incorporated shall be Council-Manager, sets forth the proposed boundaries of the proposed corporation, states that the name shall be the City of Federal Way and that the number of inhabitants therein as nearly as may be determined, is 50,100 and prays that it may be incorporated.

The superintendent of elections has determined that the petition for incorporation does not violate the prohibitions contained in RCW 35A.03.010 with regard to number of inhabitants and that there are a sufficient number of valid signatures on the petition.

Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.93.100 the Boundary Review Board invoked jurisdiction and in accordance with RCW 36.93.160 on July 23, 1985, filed its written decision approving the proposed incorporation as submitted.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Boundary Review Board has deemed the proposed incorporation of the City of Federal Way approved as submitted as of July 23, 1985.

SECTION 2. The name of the proposed city shall be Federal Way.

SECTION 3. The official population of the proposed City of Federal Way, if incorporated, shall be 50,100.

1 SECTION 4. A special election shall be held on the
2 November 5, 1985, within the area of the proposed City of
3 Federal Way, as hereinafter described, for the purpose of
4 submitting to the qualified electors the determination of
5 whether it shall be incorporated as a noncharter code city, and
6 to elect officers under the Council-Manager plan of government
7 proposed in the petition.

8 SECTION 5. The boundaries of the proposed City of Federal
9 Way approved as submitted by the Boundary Review Board are
10 hereby described as follows:

11 Beginning at a point 580 feet more or less westerly of
12 and 50 feet southerly of the NE corner of the NE 1/4
13 of Section 33, Twp 22N., Rge 4E., W.M. King County
14 Washington, said point being also identified as the
15 south margin of S. 272nd Street and Easterly Limited
16 Easterly Limited Access Line of SR 5; thence Southerly along said
17 Easterly Limited Access Line of SR 5 to its
18 intersection with the North City Limits of Milton as
19 annexed by City Ordinance No. 810; thence Westerly and
20 Southwesterly along said City Limits to its
21 intersection with that area as annexed to the City of
22 Milton by City Ordinance No. 794; thence continuing
23 generally Southwesterly along said City Limits to the
24 most Westerly point of said annexation area; thence
25 continuing Southwesterly along the Westerly right of
26 way margin of SR 5 (AKA the Westerly line of the area
27 designated "Beautification Area" P.C. Line to Junction
28 SSH No. 5-A, Sheet 1 of 20) to the South line of King
29 County;

30 Thence West, North, and Northwesterly along said South
31 line of King County to its intersection with the East
32 shore of Puget Sound; thence generally Northeasterly
33 along the shoreline of Puget Sound to its intersection
with the Northerly projection of the West margin of
1st Avenue South in the NE 1/4 Section 6, Twp. 21N.,
Rge 4E., W.M.; thence South along said projection and
West margin to its intersection with the Westerly
projection of the South line of Gov. Lot 4 in the NW
1/4 Section 5, Twp. 21 N., Rge. 4E., W.M.; thence East
along said projection and South line to the Southeast
corner of Gov. Lot 4; thence North along the East line
of Gov. Lot 4 to its intersection with the Southwest
boundary of the plat of Marine Hills West recorded in
Volume 98, pages 53-55 records of King County; thence
Northwesterly and Northeasterly along the Western
boundary of said plat to the North line of said Gov.
Lot 4; thence East along the North line of Gov. Lot 4
to the NW corner of Lot 24 Marine Hills, No. 17 as
recorded in Volume 98 of plats pages 50-52 records of
King County;

1 Thence East and continuing generally Northeasterly
2 along the North westerly boundary of said plat to the
3 most northern point of Lot 6; thence Southeasterly to
4 the most Northerly point of Lot 76 Marine Hills East
5 as recorded in Volume 97 pages 76-77 records of King
6 County; thence Southeasterly, Northerly, Easterly, and
7 Southerly along the boundary of said plat to the NW
8 corner of Tract A (also being the SE corner of Lot
9 63); thence Easterly along the North line of Tract A
10 to the West margin of Redondo Way South; thence South
11 along said margin to the South line of the SW 1/4 of
12 the SE 1/4 Section 32, Twp. 22 N., Rge. 4 E., W.M.;
13 thence East to the East line of said SW 1/4 of the SE
14 1/4 of Section 32; thence North along said East line
15 to the South margin of South 284th Street; thence East
16 along said South margin to the West line of the SW 1/4
17 of Section 33, Twp. 22 N., Rge. 4E., W.M.;

18 Thence North along said West line to the North line of
19 the S 1/2 of said SW 1/4 section 33; thence east along
20 said North line to the East margin of Pacific Highway
21 South (State Rd #1); thence North along said East
22 margin to the South margin of S. 272nd Street, said
23 point being on the South line of the North 38 feet of
24 the NW 1/4 of said Section 33; thence East along the
25 South line of the North 38 feet of the NW 1/4 of
26 Section 33 to its intersection with that 25 foot
27 radius curve at the Westerly most end of Lot 14
28 Redondo Heights Unrec'd as established by AF
29 7312130230 records of King County Washington; thence
30 continuing Easterly along said curve and South margin
31 of S. 272nd Street to the most Westerly point of that
32 area that lies 50 feet South of the North line of the
33 NE 1/4 of said Section 33 as described in AF
7404160281 records of King County Washington; thence
continuing East along the South line of the North 50
feet of said NE 1/4 to the Point of Beginning.

SECTION 6. The election shall be conducted pursuant to RCW
35A.03.085, RCW 35A.03.090, RCW 35A.03.100, RCW 35A.03.110 and
RCW 35A.03.120.
