ORDINANCE NO. 7341

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$5,088,800 for various CIP projects from proceeds of a 1985 Limited Tax General Obligation bond issue; transferring \$193,070 to the Parks Facilities Rehabilitation Fund; and amending Ordinance No. 7027, Sections 83 and 84, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$800,000 for CIP Project No. 002301, Police Shooting Ranges from 1985 Councilmanic bond proceeds; \$50,000 of the \$750,000 shall be used for site study, design and project administration and the balance of \$764,000 is to be placed in contingency and shall not be expended without Council approval of the site study, program plan and project budget.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$600,000 for CIP Project No. 002302, Surrey Downs Complex for acquisition only; from 1985 Councilmanic bond proceeds.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$430,000 for CIP Project No. 007124, West Sammamish Trail; \$1,000,000 for CIP Project No. 070133, Petrovitsky/Lake Desire; \$94,750 of the \$1,000,000 shall be used for master plan development and the balance of \$905,250 is to be placed in contingency and shall not be used without council approval of the master plan and project budget; \$1,200,000 for CIP Project No. 007200, Green River Trail; \$500,000 of the \$1,200,000 shall be used for initial acquisition and the balance of \$700,000 is to be placed in contingency and shall not be expended without council approval

1 of the master plan and project budget; and \$500,000 for CIP  
2 Project No. 007150, Missing Link Trail, for public  
3 transportation uses, including recreational trails and bicycle  
4 paths, for King County and other governmental entities; from  
5 1985 councilmanic bond proceeds.

6 SECTION 4. There is hereby approved and adopted an  
7 appropriation of \$751,870 to CIP Project No. 010021, Hamlin  
8 Park, for design and development of the park and for payment of  
9 bond issuance costs; from 1985 councilmanic bond proceeds of  
10 \$558,800 and from a transfer of \$193,070 from CIP Project No.  
11 040205, Hamlin Park.

12 SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 7027, Section 83 as amended, is  
13 hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the  
14 following:

15 From the several capital improvement project funds there  
16 are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the  
17 following amounts for the specific projects identified.
