- l. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 20th Avenue South and South 144th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed road vacation.
- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area had ever been open as a road. No evidence was found that public funds had been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "Class C" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. Records of the director of finance indicate that one abutting property owner has not signed the petition for vacation. Tax Account No. 212304-9177 is listed under the name of Philip S. Lester, whose signature does not appear on the petition. The Port of Seattle has signed the petition representing the property listed under that tax account.
- 6. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the day of september, 1985.
