AN ORDINANCE approving an amendment to the
Water District 107 Sewer Plan

PREAMBLE:

On April 1, 1981, the King County council passed Ordinance No. 5384, approving the Water District 107 Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On June 12, 1985, Water District 107 adopted Resolution No. 827 amending their Sewer Plan, to provide for sewer service to an area in the southeast quarter of the district, in the vicinity of Lake Boren. Water District 107 issued a Declaration of Non-significance for the proposed amendment.

On July 2, 1985 the amendment was reviewed by the Utilities Technical Review Committee as required by K.C.C. 13.24. The committee recommended approval with conditions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Resolution No. 827 of Water District 107 is

hereby approved, with the following conditions:

A. Approval of this amendment does not include approval of any other permit, and

B. All sewer lines in the May Creek Drainage Basin will connect to gravity mains, if it becomes available.
