- 3. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed road vacation.
- 4. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed plat vacation and finds that the preliminary approved planned unit development of Ocean Ridge Division 3 (File No. 231-84-P) has provided an acceptable alternative street pattern. As such, that division would have no objection to the proposed vacation, upon assurance of the recording of the planned unit development.
