ORDINANCE NO. 7380

AN ORDINANCE regulating waterskiing activities in King County, repealing a subsection of Ordinance #1235, Sec. 5 and K.C.C. 12.44.230.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Section 5, Ordinance 1235, and King County Code 12.44.230, are each amended to read as follows:

Water skiing on King County lakes and rivers shall be regulated as follows:

- A. No watercraft which has in tow a person on water skis, aquaplane, surfboad or similar contrivance shall be operated or propelled in the waters of King County unless such watercraft is occupied by at least two competent persons.
- B. It is unlawful to water ski within one hundred yards of shore. Water skiers may start at and return to shore by means of the most expeditious route. For purposes of starting at and returning to shore, water skiers may temporarily exceed the speed limit of eight miles per hour.
- C. No operator of a watercraft shall have in tow a person on water skis, aquaplane, surfboard or similar contrivance from sunset to sunrise.
- D. All persons being towed by watercraft shall wear an adequate flotation device.
- E. All watercraft having in tow or otherwise assisting a person on water skis, aquaplanes, surfboards or similar contrivance shall comply with Sections 12.44.040, 12.44.050 and 12.44.060.
- F. Regulations stated in subsections A. and D. of this section shall not apply to watercraft used in water ski tournaments, competitions, expositions, or trials therefor, which have been duly authorized by the King County Department of Public Safety.
