

ORDINANCE NO. 7396

1 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the
2 Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County
3 Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying
4 certain property upon the application of FORREST MILLER,
5 designated Building and Land Development File No. 116-85-R.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and
8 conclusions of the October 16, 1985 report of the zoning and subdivision exam-
9 iner, filed with the clerk of the council on October 31, 1985 to reclassify
10 certain property described in the building and land development file no.
11 116-85-R.

12 SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to
13 reclassify the subject property from G (potential MP) to MP-P on the north 311+
14 feet (tax lot 157) subject to pre and post-effective conditions and MP-P for the
15 remaining southerly 331+ feet (tax lot 60) subject to pre and post-effective
16 conditions is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions,
17 if any, which must be met before this ordinance becomes effective must be
18 satisfied on or before September 1, 1987, or all authority granted by this
19 ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or
20 effect. The council may extend this date by motion pursuant to KCC 20.24.230.
21 Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and land development
22 division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this
23 action.
