ORDINANCE NO. 7402

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Holyrood Cemetery West to Ronald Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- l. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Holyrood Cemetery West to Ronald Sewer District was filed with the county council effective October 21, 1985.
- 2. Ronald Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 85-32 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Ronald Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated August 8, 1985, on the proposed annexation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Ronald Sewer District of the area known as Holyrood Cemetery West and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Holyrood Cemetery West.

SECTION 2. The Ronald Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.
