

ORDINANCE NO. 7410

1 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the
2 Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County
3 Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying
4 certain property upon the application of Angelo Vacca,
5 designated Building and Land Development Division File
6 No. 236-85-R.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and
9 conclusions of the October 30, 1985 report of the zoning and subdivision
10 examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on November 14, 1985 on the
11 application of Angelo Vacca to reclassify certain property described in
12 building and land development file no. 236-85-R.

13 SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to
14 reclassify the subject property from RS 7200 (Potential RM 900) to RM 900-P
15 subject to conditions is hereby adopted by the council of King County.
16 Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance
17 becomes effective must be satisfied within 2 years of council approval, or
18 all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance
19 shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall
20 be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the
21 building and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps
22 of King County to reflect this action.
