ORDINANCE NO. 7435

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Annexation 85-1 to King County Water District No. 82 for the provision of water service.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Annexation No. 85-1 to King County Water District No. 82 was filed with the county council effective June 25, 1985.

2. King County Water District No. 82 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution A-620 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 82 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated April 26, 1985, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 29th day of July, 1985 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060 and 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of King County Water District No. 82 of the area known as Annexation 85-1 for the provision of water service and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Annexation 85-1.

SECTION 2. The King County Water District No. 82 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

1 SECTION 4. The area known as Annexation 85-1 to be annexed is
2 described as follows:

3 Situated in Section 22 and Section 15, Township 24 North,
4 Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington, described as
5 follows:

6 Beginning at the southeast corner of Section 22; THENCE west
7 along the south line of said Section 22 to the southwest
8 corner, southeast quarter, Section 22;

9 THENCE north along the west line of said southeast quarter to
10 the westerly margin of Vaughn Hill Road;

11 THENCE northeasterly along the westerly margin of Vaughn Hill
12 Road to its intersection with the southerly margin of
13 Southeast 58th Street;

14 THENCE west along the southerly margin of Southeast 58th
15 Street to the west line of the southeast quarter of Section 22;

16 THENCE north along the west line of said southeast quarter AND
17 the northeast quarter to the northwest corner, northeast
18 quarter, Section 22;

19 THENCE east along the north line of said northeast quarter to
20 the southwest corner, southeast quarter, southeast quarter,
21 Section 15;

22 THENCE north along the west line of said southeast quarter,
23 southeast quarter, Section 15 to the northwest corner of said
24 southeast quarter, southeast quarter;

25 THENCE east to the east line of Section 15; THENCE south along
26 the east line of Section 15 and Section 22 to the southerly
27 margin of the Issaquah-Fall City Road;

28 THENCE southwesterly along the southerly margin of the
29 Issaquah-Fall City Road to the northerly corner of the Vaughn
30 Hill Addition (Recording Number 889000);

31 THENCE southeasterly along the easterly line of said Vaughn
32 Hill Addition to the southeast corner of said addition;

33 THENCE west along the south line of said Vaughn Hill Addition
34 to a point on the west line of the southeast quarter,
35 northeast quarter, Section 22;

36 THENCE south along the west line of said southeast quarter,
37 northeast quarter to the southwest corner of said southeast
38 quarter, northeast quarter;

39 THENCE east along the south line of said southeast quarter,
40 northeast quarter to the east line of Section 22;

1 THENCE south along the east line of Section 22 to the point of
2 beginning.

3 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 8th day
4 of July, 1985.
