- 4. The vacation area is a portion of Matt Paananen Road No. 1319 established October 25, 1926. This county maintained road was revised in 1971 with a new alignment selected southerly of the original road. King county purchased the right of way for the new alignment at that time. The vacation area lies outside of the 60 foot right of way required for N.E. 122nd Place/N.E. 123rd Street. King county shall retain an adequate turning radius along the east margin of 80th Avenue N.E. in the vicinity of this vacation. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls. In accordance with county ordinance No. 2759, the vacation area is classified "B Class."
