AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of territory known as 8th Avenue South/South 156th Street, from King County Water District No. 20.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of terrirory known as 8th Avenue South/South 156th Street from King County Water District No. 20 was filed with the county council effective November 18, 1985.
- King County Water District No. 20 has found the petition for withdrawal to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 504 concurred with the proposed withdrawal.
- 3. King County Water District No. 20 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated August 25, 1985, on the proposed withdrawal.
- 4. The county council held a public hearing on the  $30^{\circ}$  day of December, 1985 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal by King County Water District No. 20 of the area known as 8th Avenue South/South 156th Street and described in Section 2 herein is approved. This proposed withdrawal is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Withdrawal Report on 8th Avenue South/South 156th Street.
