## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- l. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of an alley in the plat of Southern Pacific Land Company's Huntington Park Addition to Des Moines, hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilites serving the area and was advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed alley vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the plat of Southern Pacific Land Company's Huntington Park Addition to Des Moines recorded October 14, 1889 in Volume 4 of Plats, page 24, records of King County. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The alley is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of the public works considers subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 13th day January , 1986
