7480 ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to personnel administration; transferring the administration of the sheriff's civil service system to the personnel system established by Article 5 of the County Charter; repealing Ordinance 3390, and K.C.C. 3.14.010.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 3390, Section 1, and K.C.C. 3.14.010 are hereby repealed.

NEW SECTION SECTION 2. The administration of the sheriff's civil service system, established within King County pursuant to R.C.W. 41.14, is transferred to the county personnel division as provided in Article 970.50 of the county charter, and R.C.W. 41.14.010. The existing civil service system shall essentially remain in effect, including the civil service commission and chief examiner, and all existing civil service rules and regulations, until such time as special personnel rules have been adopted by ordinance which will substantially accomplish the purpose of R.C.W. 41.14. Such rules shall be in addition to the personnel rules established in K.C.C. 3.12 as are necessary to assure that the rights, privileges and protections granted to the deputy sheriffs and other public safety personnel heretofore covered by the sheriff's civil service system are not decreased or eliminated.

Provided that:

The executive shall transmit to the council for review not

later than May 1st, 1986, the proposed special personnel rules required to conform with the conditions of this ordinance. The proposed special personnel rules shall become effective upon approval by Council motion. INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 940 day of <u>Pelember</u>, 1985.
