

ORDINANCE NO. 7488

AN ORDINANCE making appropriations of \$125,300 to the surface water management division from the River Improvement fund balance, \$1,401,875 to the County Roads Fund from the County Roads fund balance, \$250,000 to C.I.P. Project No. 026012 Parks Storm Damage from the Real Estate Excise Tax fund balance, \$283,675 to C.I.P. Project No. 003090 Vashon Landfill Storm Damage from the Solid Waste 1981 Construction fund balance, \$250,000 to the Real Estate Excise Tax Fund; amending Ordinance No. 7422, Sections 47, 48, 56, and 78, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

Preamble:

The King County executive, by local proclamation of emergency on January 21, 1986, declared an emergency due to heavy rainfall, mudslides and flooding conditions.

This proclamation authorized designated King County departments to enter into contracts and incur obligations necessary to protect health and safety of persons and property, and to provide emergency assistance to victims of the emergency. Exercise of these powers was exempted from time consuming procedures and formalities but not mandatory constitutional requirements.

The King County council by Motion No. 6457 declared the existence of an emergency, designated county agencies to repair damage, specifically waived bidding and Minority and Women's Business Enterprise requirements for these repairs and ratified and confirmed the local proclamation of emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$125,300 to the surface water management division from the River Improvement fund balance for the purpose of repairing storm damage.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 7422, Section 48, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SURFACE WATER MANAGEMENT/RIVER IMPROVEMENT - From the River Improvement Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

SECTION 8. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$250,000 to the Real Estate Excise Tax Fund from the unappropriated fund balance.

SECTION 9. Ordinance No. 7422, Section 56, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

REAL ESTATE EXCISE TAX - From the Real Estate Tax Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Real Estate Tax Fund \$250,000

SECTION 10. The project information sheets attached hereto are adopted to amend and revise the 1986 Capital Improvement Budget and Program, amending Ordinance No. 7422, Section 78, Attachment 1, as amended.

SECTION 11. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
