AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 172nd Avenue S.E. Petitioner: Patrick E. Ryan and amending Ordinance 7163.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 172nd Avenue, hereinafter described.
- The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The vacation area was dedicated in the Plat of Willow Ridge Tracts recorded in Volume 38 of Plats, page 26. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has even been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759. The road is,
- The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the 25th day of March, 1985.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 25th day of March, 1985, hereby vacates and abandons the portion of 172nd Avenue S.E., described as follows:
