AN ORDINANCE approving the North Bend
Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On March 18, 1985, North Bend filed a declaration of
nonsignificance, as per WAC 197-11.

On July 2, 1985, North Bend adopted Ordinance 657,
approving the North Bend Comprehensive Water Plan.

On November 26, 1985, North Bend adopted Resolution 528,
requiring annexation or a covenant to annex prior to water
service.

On January 7, 1986, North Bend Comprehensive Water Plan was
reviewed by the Utilities Technical Review Committee
(UTRC). The committee recommended approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The 1985 North Bend Comprehensive Water Plan
(attached) is approved. This approval does not constitute King
County approval or endorsement of the restrictions on water
service contained in North Bend Resolution 528.

Provided that:

No additions or betterments to the existing water system
for purposes of providing water service to unincorporated areas
of King County, outside the approved water service area as
defined in Chapter 1 of the plan, shall be considered for
approval until adoption of the Snoqualmie Community Plan.
