SECTION 1. The director of the department of public works has made an examination of Southeast 56th Street along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2. Said road shall be established not less than 100 feet in width, having 50 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline: Commencing at the west quarter corner of Section 21, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; thence South 88°54'49" East 2325.53 feet; thence South 87°32'49" East 267.17 feet to the west line of the northeast quarter of said Section 21 and the point of beginning of the herein described establishment and designated as Engineer's Station 2+51.86 (Southeast 56th Street) as surveyed by King County (Survey No. 21-24-6-9); thence South 87°32'49" East 748.14 feet to the terminus point, said point being North 88°30'37" West 1880.85 feet from the east quarter corner of Section 21, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M.
