

ORDINANCE NO. **7560**

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of South 316th Street (Pacific Highway to 20th Avenue South)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The director of the department of public works has made an examination of South 316th Street (Pacific Highway to 20th Avenue South) along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet of width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the Southwest corner Section 9, Township 21 North, Range 4 East; Thence N 0° 09' 03" W 1290.75, Thence N 89° 35' 34" W 1.22 feet to the true point of beginning; Thence S 89° 35' 34" E 350.00 feet; Thence along a tangent curve to the left having a radius of 660.00 feet through a central angle of 12° 14' 20" an arc distance of 140.98 feet; Thence along a tangent curve to the right having a radius of 660.00 feet through a central angle of 12° 14' 20" an arc distance of 140.98 feet; Thence S 89° 35' 34" E a distance of 679.95 feet to the Terminus; said Terminus being N 89° 34' 08" W 1304.27 feet; Thence N 0° 02' 52" E 1321.26 feet from the south quarter corner of said Section 9.

1311.91 linear feet = 0.248 mile

SECTION 3: King County council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
