ORDINANCE NO. 7568

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Reber to King County Water District No. 111.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Reber to King County Water District No. 111 was filed with the county council effective October 7, 1985.

2. King County Water District No. 111 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 200-6-85 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 111 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated September 12, 1985, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 14th day of April, 1986 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 111 of the area known as Reber and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Reber.

SECTION 2. King County Water District No. 111 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

1 SECTION 4. The area known as Reber to be annexed is described
2 as follows:

3 That portion of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 3, the
4 Northeast 1/4 of Section 4, Township 21 North, Range 5
5 East W.M., and that portion of the Southeast 1/4 of
6 Section 33, and the Southwest 1/4 of Section 34,
7 Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., described as
8 follows:

9 Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4
10 of said Section 33, thence Northerly along the West
11 line thereof to the Northwest corner of the South 1/2
12 of the said Southeast 1/4;

13 Thence Easterly along the North line thereof to its
14 intersection with the West line of the East 1/2 of the
15 Southeast 1/4;

16 Thence Northerly along said West line to its
17 intersection with the North line of the South 1/2 of
18 the North 1/2 of the said Southeast 1/4;

19 Thence Easterly along said North line to its
20 intersection with the West line of the Southwest 1/4 of
21 said Section 34;

22 Thence Northerly along said West line to the Northwest
23 corner of the said Southwest 1/4;

24 Thence Easterly along the North line thereof to the
25 Northeast corner of the West 1/2 of the said Southwest
26 1/4;

27 Thence Southerly along the East line thereof and the
28 East line of Govt. Lot 4 of said Section 3 to its
29 intersection with the Ely projection of the South line
30 of the North 1/2 of the North 1/2 of Govt. Lot 1 of
31 said Section 4;

32 Thence Westerly along said projection and the South
33 line to the West line of Govt. Lot 1 of said Section 4;

34 Thence Southerly along said West line to the South line
35 of the North 790 feet of Govt. Lot 2;

36 Thence Westerly along said South line to the West line
37 of the East 180 feet of the West 660 feet of said Govt.
38 Lot 2;

39 Thence Northerly along said West line to the South line
40 of the South 330 feet of the North 660 feet of said
41 Govt. Lot 2;

42 Thence Westerly along said South line to its
43 intersection with the West line of said govt. Lot 2;

Thence Northerly along said West line to the Northwest corner of said Govt. Lot 2 of Section 4, which is also the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 33 and the Point of Beginning.
