ORDINANCE NO. 2599

AN ORDINANCE approving the Snoqualmie Pass Comprehensive Water Plan amendment with conditions.

PREAMBLE:

On May 10, 1985, the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significance under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(C)

On February 12, 1986, the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer District approved their 1986 Comprehensive Water Plan.

On March 4, 1986, the Snoqualmie Pass Comprehensive Water Plan was reviewed by the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC). The committee recommended approval.

SECTION 1. The Snoqualmie Pass Comprehensive Water Plan (attached) is approved.

SECTION 2. If the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer District consolidates with or signs an agreement to operate the Alpentel Water System, an updated comprehensive water plan shall be prepared.

SECTION 3. The Snoqualmie Pass Sewer District shall resubmit the comprehensive water plan for review to the UTRC May 1, 1991. If significant changes have occurred in the area, then the UTRC may require a revised or new plan.
