## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as DS 86-1 to Des Moines Sewer District was filed with the county council effective March 20, 1986.
- Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition for 2. annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 1986-14 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- Des Moines Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated February 26, 1986, on the proposed annexation.
- The county council held a public hearing on the 54 day 4. \_\_\_\_, 1986 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Des Moines Sewer District of the area known as DS 86-1 and described in Section 4 herein is This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. approved. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on DS 86-1.

SECTION 2. The Des Moines Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County Sewerage General Plan.
