AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as DS-86-4 to Des Moines Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as DS-86-4 to Des Moines Sewer District was filed with the county council effective April 8, 1986.
- Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 1986-17 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- Des Moines Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated February 26, 1986, on the proposed annexation.
- The county council held a public hearing on the 544 day 1986 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Des Moines Sewer District of the area known as DS-86-4 and described in Section 4 herein is This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. approved. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on DS-86-4.
