AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of UNIVERSITY MORTGAGE AND INVESTMENT CO., designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 203-86-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify the subject property from RS 7200 (Potential RD 3600); RD 3600; and RM 900-P to RM 2400-P subject to pre-effective and post-effective conditions (modified) is hereby adopted by the council of King County.
