ORDINANCE NO. 7881

AN ORDINANCE approving the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer and Water District's Hyak Amendment for sewer and water service.

PREAMBLE:

On June 23, 1980, the King County council passed Ordinance 4953, approving the Kittitas County No. 1 Sewer District Plan.

On February 25, 1986, the Kittitas County No. 1 Sewer District was renamed the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer and Water District.

On July 19, 1985, the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer and Water District passed Resolution 85-2, approving the Hyak Amendment to the District's sewer and water plans.

On January 21, 1986, the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer District submitted the Hyak Amendment (District Resolution 85-2) to the Utilities Technical Review Committee.

On February 11, 1986, the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer District issued a declaration of non-significance for the Hyak Amendment.

On March 18, 1986, the Utilities Technical Reveiw Committee met and recommended approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Hyak Amendment to the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer District Comprehensive Sewer Plan and the Snoqualmie Pass Sewer District Comprehensive Water Plan is hereby approved.
