AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Coal Creek Parkway S.E. (Newcastle Road 1010) V-1829
Petitioner: Alexander and Junias Jenen & Others

1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Coal Creek Parkway S.E. (Newcastle Road 1019), hereinafter described.

- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that an easement was granted to Puget Power.
- 3. The division of building and land development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the old alignment of Renton-Newcastle Road 1019. Coal Creek Parkway S.E. (Newcastle Road) was realigned and established December 17, 1962 following the centerline identified in Survey 3-23-5-6. The area petitioned for lies outside of the 100 foot required right of way for a major arterial highway. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls. In accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, the vacation area is classified "B Class". King County is now in receipt of \$1,160.00 from the petitioner, which has been judged to be the just compensation to King County for this vacation. The owner of Tax Lot 0592, James Hunter, has not responded to our request for compensation for his portion of the vacation area. The department of public works deleted Tax Lot 0592 from the area to be vacated.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the 2124 day of 186.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 22 day of ,1986, hereby vacates and abandons the following described portion of Coal Creek Parkway (Newcastle Road 1010):

Vacate that portion of County Road 1019 Renton-Newcastle Road lying Southwesterly of a line 50 feet Southwesterly of and parallel with the centerline of Coal Creek Parkway S.E. as established by Survey No. 3-23-5-6 and identified in King County Resolution No. 26630. Said vacation area being located in the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 34, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington; EXCEPT any portion thereof lying Northerly of the Easterly extension of the South line of Lot 1, King County Short Plat 675028-7510230642, records of said county. Contains an area of 5,250 Sq.
