ORDINANCE NO. 7750

AN ORDINANCE establishing the boundaries of the Vashon Coordinated Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On December 16, 1985, the King County council passed Motion 6407, which designated Vashon Island a Critical Water Supply Area.

On May 8, 1986, the King County council passed Ordinance 7588, establishing the Vashon Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC). Section 3(c) required the Committee to develop and recommend external critical water boundaries to the King County council as per WAC 248-56-600.

On May 9, 1986 the Vashon WUCC met and recommended the mean low lower water line of Vashon and Maury Islands, as external critical boundaries.

On June 4, 1986, the Vashon WUCC conducted an informational meeting on the Vashon Critical Water Supply Plan external critical boundaries as per WAC 248-56-600(2).

On June 13, 1986, the Vashon WUCC met and approved the Vashon external critical water supply boundary report and map (attached) as per WAC 248-56-600(3).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The external critical boundaries of the Vashon Coordinated Water System Plan shall be the mean low lower water line of Vashon and Maury Islands.
