ORDINANCE NO. 7752

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation of the City of Bothell into the King County Rural Library District and <u>declaring an emergency</u>.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The City of Bothell, Washington by Ordinance No. 1221, has initiated the proposed annexation and expressed its intent to join the King County Rural Library District, finding that the public interest will be served thereby. The Board of Library Trustees of the City of Bothell declared its support of the annexation on July 30, 1986.

City of Bothell Ordinance No. 1221 does satisfy the provisions of RCW 27.12.010 (5), and 27.12.360 requesting the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein.

The Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District by Resolution No. 1986-4 has concurred with the proposal as submitted on August 20, 1986, all in accordance with RCW 27.12.360.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 4th day of November 1986 within the City of Bothell. The ballot proposition shall be in substantially the following form in accordance with RCW 27.12.370:
