AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of N. E. 195th Street V-188 v-1887 Petitioner: Dorothy Burchak and Others

1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of N. E. 195th Street, hereinafter described.

- The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that an easement was granted to Puget Power.
- 3. The division of building and land development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds it necessary to retain a walkway access through the vacation area.
- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance.
