ORDINANCE NO. 7775

AN ORDINANCE conditionally approving  
the 1985 Bellevue Water Comprehensive  
Plan and Amendment No. One.

PREAMBLE:

On May 18, 1985, the Bellevue City council passed  
Resolution 4554 adopting the 1985 Comprehensive Water  
Plan of the City of Bellevue.

On July 21, 1986, the Bellevue City council passed  
Resolution 4769 adopting Amendment No. One to the 1985  
Comprehensive Water Plan Amendment.

On May 27, 1986, the City of Bellevue completed filing  
to comply with the State Environmental Policy Act for  
their Water Plan Amendment.

On June 25, 1986, the City of Bellevue submitted the  
1985 Comprehensive Water Plan and Amendment No. One to  
the Utilities Technical Reveiw Committee (UTRC)  
pursuant to K.C.C. 13.24.

On July 1, 1986, the UTRC met and recommended  
conditional approval of the 1985 Bellevue  
Comprehensive Water Plan and Amendment No. One.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The 1985 Comprehensive Water Plan of the  
City of Bellevue adopted by City Resolution 4554 and  
Amendment No. One to the 1985 Comprehensive Water Plan as  
adopted by Resolution 4769 are each hereby approved;
