

ORDINANCE NO. 7785

AN ORDINANCE establishing the boundaries of the South King County Coordinated Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On December 16, 1985, the King County council passed Motion 6407, which designated South King County a Critical Water Supply Area.

On May 8, 1986, the King County council passed Ordinance 7589, establishing the South King County Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC). Section 3(c) required the Committee to develop and recommend external critical water boundaries to the King County council per WAC 248-56-600.

On April 21, 1986 the South King County WUCC met and recommended the external critical boundaries.

On March 17, 1986 and April 21, 1986, the South King County WUCC conducted an informational meeting on the South King County Critical Water Supply Plan external critical boundaries per WAC 248-56-600(2).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The external boundaries of the South King County Coordinated Water System Plan shall be as shown on Attachment A (South King County Regional Water Plan Study Area Map).
