ORDINANCE NO. 7791

AN ORDINANCE establishing a moratorium on issuance of new taxicab licenses in King County and amending Ordinance 6887, Section 16, and KCC 6.64.470.

PREAMBLE:

An Ad Hoc Taxi Task Force, comprised of representatives of the King County Council, the Seattle City Council, taxicab industry, hospitality industry, taxicab licensing agencies, and citizens, has recommended to the King County County Council that entry to the taxicab industry be limited in order to preserve the safety, reliability and economic viability of taxi transportation services in King County. The task force has been charged with developing criteria for limiting entry. The King County Council finds that viability of taxi transportation services is a matter of public concern and hereby establishes a moratorium on new licenses for taxicabs in King County for one year, pending development of the task force recommendations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6887, Section 16 and KCC 6.64.470 are hereby amended as follows:

Moratorium. The King County council finds and declares that privately operated taxicab transportation service is a vital part of the transportation system of King County and provides demand-responsive services to county residents and the traveling public. Consequently, the safety, reliability and economic viability of privately operated taxi transportation is a matter of county concern and regulation of such transportation is an essential governmental function.

3	to assure a viable taxi transportation system in King County, the
4	King County council finds that it is necessary and in the public
5	interest to declare a moratorium on the issuance of <u>new</u> taxicab

8	licenses issued or renewed between August 1, 1985 and the
9	effective date of this ordinance may be renewed pursuant to other
