ORDINANCE NO. 7814

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Klinkenberg to Woodinville Water District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Klinkenberg to Woodinville Water District was filed with the county council effective August 9, 1986.
- 2. Woodinville Water District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 2079 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Woodinville Water District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated August 18, 1986, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The county council held a public hearing on the 64 day of October, 1986 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Woodinville Water District of the area known as Klinkenberg and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Klinkenberg.

SECTION 2. Woodinville Water District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.
