AN ORDINANCE relating to fees charged for the use of King County parks and recreation facilities; and amending Ordinance No. 5225, as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.010 through K.C.C. 7.08.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5225, Section 2(A), and K.C.C. 7.08.010 are amended to read as follows:

All persons using King County owned and operated park and recreation facilities shall pay the service fees, which include taxes where applicable, set forth in the following schedules in this chapter, effective January 1, ((1986)) 1987. Specific service fees may also be established administratively by the parks division within the range of charges authorized by this chapter.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 5225, Section 2(A), as amended and K.C.C. 7.08.020 are amended to read as follows:
