AN ORDINANCE relating to paid parking in the courthouse complex, establishing fees and amending Ordinance No. 6599, Section 1, and K.C.C. 3.32.020, and Ordinance No. 3511, Section 5, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6599, Section 1, and K.C.C.

- 3.32.020 are hereby amended as follows:
- A. Parking fees shall be levied against all parking stalls used by vehicles in the King County automotive center and the King County courthouse, with the exception of those vehicles exempted from such fees in Section 3.32.030 and the public parking area in Section 3.32.040.
- B. Effective January 1, 1984, the basic monthly parking rate shall be \$40.00 per month for covered parking stalls and \$35.00 month for uncovered parking stalls.
- C. The department of executive administration may conduct a survey of the monthly parking rates charged for public parking in lots of ten or more spaces within the area bounded by Jackson Street on the south, Sixth Avenue on the east, Columbia Street on the north and Second Avenue on the west. Such survey and any parking fee recommendations shall be forwarded to the council for consideration during budget process.
- D. All revenues derived from parking fees shall be used to pay:
 - 1. Operating expenses;
 - Bond retirement for the garage.
- E. Effective January 1, 1987, the fee schedule for surface lot daily parking shall be:

General public on county business:

Free parking 0-2 hours

1	General public on county business who exceed the two hour limit,	
2	general public not on county business and county employees:	
3	\$2.00 0-2 hours	
4	\$4.00 2-4 hours	
5	\$5.00 4-10 hours	
6	\$4.00 Evenings after 6 p.m. and all day Saturday, Sunday

8	SECTION 2. Ordinance 3511, Section 5, and K.C.C. 3.32.040	
9	are hereby amended to read as follows:	
10	Public parking area. Parking space will be established for	
11	public parking (without-charge) to be used in connection with	
12	county business. Free (P)public parking shall be limited to	
13	two hours. Members of the public on county business shall be	
14	charged for all time parked in the event the two-hour free limit	
15	is exceeded. Exceptions may be made if they meet explicit	
16	criteria for exemptions established by the King County (administra	
17	tive-officer) department of executive administration and monitored	
18	by the King County Auditor.
