That portion of 12th Avenue Southwest lying North of Southwest 168th Street and lying South of the Easterly extension of the South line of Lot 10 of Glennis Park Addition as recorded in volume 53 of Plats, page 25, records of said County.

Contains an area of 5,380 Sq. Ft., M/L

RESERVING, however, unto King County, an easement for a pedestrian and bicycle trail, over, upon and across the ((West)) East 10 feet of the West 30 feet of the lands described.
