2 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of  
3 the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King  
4 County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by  
5 reclassifying certain property upon the application  
6 of AQUA BARN RANCH, INC., designated Building and  
7 Land Development File No. 202-85-R.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and  
10 conclusions of the October 29, 1986 revised report of the zoning and  
11 subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on December 4, 1986  
12 on the application of Aqua Barn Ranch, Inc. to reclassify certain property  
13 described in building and land development file no. 202-85-R.

14 SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to  
15 reclassify the subject property from S-R (9600) GR-2.5 to RMHP-P subject to  
16 conditions (modified) is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those  
17 conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes  
18 effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all  
19 authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be  
20 of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days  
21 after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and  
22 land development division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County  
23 to reflect this action.
