AN ORDINANCE relating to zoning; modifying the provisions of the general commercial and the light manufacturing classifications to allow churches and other houses of worship as a permitted use; and amending Ordinance 3293 Subsection 2, and K.C.C. 21.30.020; and Ordinance 1929 Subsection 1, and K.C.C. 21.32.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3293, Subsection 2 and K.C.C. 21.30.020 are each hereby amended as follows:

Permitted uses - Retail sales and service. In a C-G zone the following retail sales and services uses are permitted:

A. Any use permitted in the B-N and B-C classification, except:

## ((1. Churches.))

((2-))1. Private clubs, fraternal societies, fraternities, sororities and lodges, except those the chief activity of which is a service customarily carried on as a business; however, any use permitted to locate in a B-C zone which is subject to restrictions as to location with reference to schools, parks and playgrounds and any use requiring a conditional use permit shall be subject to the same restrictions and limitations in the classification;

- B. Ambulance service;
- C. Auction houses or stores, but excluding vehicles and livestock;
- D. Automobile carwash establishments;
- E. Automobile sales, new and used;
- F. Automobile trailer sales, new and used;
- G. Blueprinting and photostating;
- H. Boat sales, new and used;
- I. Building materials stores and yards, retail only;

SECTION 2. Ordinance 1929, Section 1 and K.C.C. 21.32.020 are each hereby amended as follows:

Permitted Uses. The following permitted uses only are permitted and specifically provided and allowed by this chapter:

- A. Any use first permitted in the CG classification provided however a dwelling shall be permitted on the same lot or site on which an industrial use is located when the dwelling is used exclusively by a caretaker or superintendent of such enterprise and his family;
  - B. Advertising structures (billboards);
- Automobile body and fender works when operated and maintained wholly within an entirely enclosed building;
- Automobile assembly plant, when contained within a wholly enclosed building;
- Automobile painting, provided all painting, sanding and baking shall be conducted wholly within an enclosed building;
  - Automotive service stations; F.
  - G. Bag cleaning and conditioning;
  - Bakeries, wholesale; Η.
  - I. Banks;
  - Battery manufacture and rebuilding; J.
  - Κ. Bleaching and dyeing plants;
  - Blueprinting and photostating;
- Boat building and repairing for boats not exceeding one hundred ten feet in length;

Bottling plants; 8 N. 2 Broom and brush manufacture; 0. Building materials storage yards; 3 P. Carpet and rug cleaning plants; Q. 5 Ceramic products, manufacture of wall and floor tile and 6 related small tile products, but not including bricks, drain, 7 building or conduit tile; 8 S. Clothes cleaning or clothes dyeing plants; 9 T. Contractor's storage yards; Cosmetics, manufacture of; 10 U. Creameries and dairy products manufacture; V. 11 W. Die casting; 12 Х. Distributing plants (jobbers); 13 Υ. Dog pounds; 14 Electrical appliances, manufacture and assembly of; **Z** . 15 AA. Electric neon sign manufacturing; 16 BB. LL. Manufacture, processing, treatment or assembly of articles from previously prepared materials such as bone, canvas, cellophane, cork, fibre, felt, fur, feathers, glass, leather, paper, metal, stone, wood, yarn, plastics and shell;

MM. Metal, manufacture and fabrication of products from (except major structural steel forms, boiler making and similar activities involving excessive noise, or major trucking in terms or over-standard dimensions per unit or over-standard dimensions of load);

- NN. Parcel service delivery terminals;
- OO. Parking lots, public provided any area so used shall be improved and maintained as required by Chapter 16.74 of this code;
- PP. Pharmaceuticals, manufacturing, processing, packaging and storage of, including drugs, perfumes, toiletries and soap (cold mix only);
  - QQ. Plumbing supply yards;
  - RR. Prefabricated building, manufacture of (no concrete);
- SS. Pipe line booster or pumping plant in connection with water, oil, petroleum, gas, gasoline or other petroleum products;
  - TT. Printing and printing ink manufacture;
- UU. Public utility service facilities, yards or electric transmission substations;
  - VV. Restaurants, including cocktail lounges;
- WW. Rubber, fabrication of products made from finished rubber;
- XX. Storage of impounded and damaged cars, but no wrecking yards;
- YY. Storage for transit and transportation equipment, except freight classification yards;
  - ZZ. Textile manufacture, processing or treatment;

- (A) Tile, manufacture of wall and floor tile and related small tile products;
  - (B) Tobacco products, manufacture of;
  - (C) Truck repairing and rental;
  - (D) Upholstering;
  - (E) Vacuum metalization;
  - (F) Warehousing;
- (G) Accessory buildings and uses customarily incident to any of the above uses, when located on the same site with the main building;
- (H) Other similar industrial enterprises or businesses as set forth in Section 21.46.050 of this title;
  - (I) Planned unit development as provided in Chapter 21.56;
  - (J) Unclassified uses as provided in Chapter 21.44;
  - (K) Business and professional offices;
- (L) Enterprises selling alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption;
  - (M) Police and fire stations;
- (N) Interim use for agricultural crops, open field growing, pasturing and grazing on five acres or more, provided;
  - Buildings are not permitted;
- 2. Any pen or structure used to confine or feed livestock shall not be located closer than seventy-five feet and in the case of swine or goats no closer than one hundred fifty feet to any boundary property line nor closer than forty-five feet to any building containing a dwelling unit or accessory living quarters on the same premises,
- 3. Any pasturing or grazing shall be adequately fenced and shall maintain a distance of thirty-five feet from any boundary property line which is a common line with SR or R zoned property when such property is developed,

1	4. The number of livestock shall not exceed that per-
2	mitted in the SR zone,
3	5. Any open-air storage of hay, straw, shavings or simi-
4	lar organic materials shall maintain a distance of not less than
5	thirty-five feet from any boundary property line, and a distance
6	of not less than forty-five feet from any building containing a
7	dwelling unit or accessory living quarters on the same premises.
8	(O) Small convenience retail stores not to exceed three
9	thousand square feet or gross floor area.
10	(P) Churches and other houses of worship.
