ORDINANCE NO. 8035

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of
an area known as Golden Ridge to King
County Water District No. 105.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Golden Ridge to King County Water District No. 105 was filed with the county council effective March 25, 1987.

2. King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 1153 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 105 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated February 18, 1987 on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 27th day of April, 1987 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Golden Ridge and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Golden Ridge.

SECTION 2. King County Water District No. 105 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

1 SECTION 4. The area known as Golden Ridge to be annexed is
2 described as follows:

3 The following description incorporates that portion of the
4 above-referenced project to be annexed to King County Water
5 District No. 105.

6 The West one-half of Government Lot 3 of Section 18, Township 21
7 North, Range 6 East, W.M., in King County, Washington;

8 AND the West one-half of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest
9 quarter of Section 18, Township 21 North, Range 6 East, W.M., in
10 King County, Washington;

11 EXCEPT any portion thereof for H. H. Howard County Road;

12 TOGETHER WITH that portion of the Northeast quarter of the
13 Northwest quarter of said Section 18 lying Southerly of H. H.
14 Howard County Road as now established.

15 All situate in the County of King, Sate of Washington.
