ORDINANCE NO. 8047

AN ORDINANCE relating to housing and community development adopting King County's Community Development Block Grant Program for 1987; repealing Ordinance 7864, Section 63, adding new sections to Ordinance 7864, and increasing the appropriation to the Community Development Block Grant Fund by \$165,887.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 7864, Section 63, is hereby repealed.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> <u>SECTION 2.</u> There is added to Ordinance No. 7864 a new section to read as follows:

The projects listed in Section 4 of this ordinance are hereby adopted and approved in the funding categories and amounts therein specified and the King County executive is hereby authorized to submit the approved projects to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, hereinafter referred to as "HUD."

Provided that:

All projects have received Joint Policy Committee approval in the exact funding categories and amounts listed in this ordinance.

Provided further:

Projects identified as being funded with prior years funds in the amount of \$1,350,824 and \$275,160 from program income will be included with the 1987 CDBG Program submitted to HUD and will be shown as amendments to the appropriate program years from which funds are being made available, as required by HUD.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> <u>SECTION 3.</u> There is added to Ordinance No. 7864 a new section to read as follows:

Upon request by a consortium jurisdiction through a duly adopted resolution of such jurisdiction; and upon a determination by the planning and community development division manager that such action would conform to the goals and objectives contained in the Act, the King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan for 1987, and the Federal CDBG
