- 2. The division of building and land development has reviewed the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 4. Ownership of the vacation area appears to be questionable. In an effort to clarify title for the petitioners of this action, the Washington State Department of Transportation has indicated its willingness to issue quit claim deeds to the adjoining owners and has encouraged the department of public works to proceed with the vacation process for the same area. In the opionion of the Washington State Department of Transportation, this vacation is essential in order for these owners to enjoy a "perfection" of title to land in question. The department of public works found no evidence that the road has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
