ORDINANCE NO. 8097

AN ORDINANCE relating to county employee retirees, seeking county reemployment; amending Ordinance 4324, Section 33 and K.C.C. 3.12.320.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 4324, Section 33 and K.C.C. 3.12.320 are each hereby amended as follows:

Retirement from county employment shall be Retirement. administered in accordance with provisions set forth in state law, RCW Chapter 41.40. ((For-employees-hired-on-or-before September-30;-1977;-retirement-from-regular-county-employment shall-occur-on-the-first-month-following-the-occurrence-of-the employee's-seventieth-birthday:--For-employees-hired-after September-30;-1977;-and-for-elected-officials;-there-shall-be-no mandatory-retirement-age:--Former-employees-who-have-retired-from county-employment-shall-be-eligible-for-extra-help-employment-on the-same-basis-as-other-applicants;-but-in-no-event-to-exceed five-hundred-twenty-hours-in-any-one-ealendar-year:)) Former employees who have retired from county employment shall be eligible for temporary and part-time employment on the same basis as other applicants; provided that PERS Plan I retirees shall not be hired on such basis into retirement eligible positions. Per RCW 41.60.690, no PERS Plan II retiree shall be eligible to
