ORDINANCE NO. 18108

AN ORDINANCE establishing the hours of operation at solid waste disposal sites and specifying the types of waste for which each site is intended.

PREAMBLE:

In accordance with King County Ordinance 7708, Section 1.D., the council of King County shall establish by ordinance the hours of operation of disposal sites, disposal fees charged and types of waste for which each site is intended. Ordinance 7748 established disposal fees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 1987.

SECTION 2. Definitions. A. All definitions used in K.C.C. 10.08.010 shall apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this ordinance.

B. The following definitions shall also apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this ordinance:

1. "Asbestos containing waste material" means any waste that contains asbestos. This term includes, but is not limited to, asbestos waste from control devices, contaminated clothing, asbestos waste material, materials used to enclose the work area during an asbestos project, and bags or containers that previously contained asbestos.

2. "Ashes" means the residue including any air pollution control equipment flue dusts from combustion or incineration of material including solid wastes.

3. "Clean soils and clean dredge spoils" means soils and dredge spoils which are not dangerous wastes or problem wastes as defined in K.C.C. 10.08.010.

4. "Demolition wastes" means solid waste, largely inert waste, resulting from the demolition or razing of buildings,

1 roads, and other man-made structures. Demolition waste consists  
2 of, but is not limited to, concrete, brick, bituminous concrete,  
3 wood and masonry, composition roofing and roofing paper, steel,  
4 and minor amounts of other metals like copper. Plaster (i.e.,  
5 sheet rock or plaster board) or any other material, other than  
6 wood, that is likely to produce gases or a leachate during the  
7 decomposition process and asbestos wastes are not considered to  
8 be demolition waste for the purposes of this ordinance.

9 5. "Drop box facility" means a facility used for the  
10 placement of a detachable container including the area adjacent  
11 for necessary entrance and exit roads, unloading, and turnaround  
12 areas. Drop box facilities normally serve the general public  
13 with loose loads and receive waste from off-site.

14 6. "Garbage" means unwanted animal and vegetable wastes and  
15 animal and vegetable wastes resulting from the handling,  
16 preparation, cooking and consumption of food, swill, and  
17 carcasses of dead animals, and of such a character and proportion  
18 as to be capable of attracting or providing food for vectors,  
19 except sewage and sewage sludge.

20 7. "Health officer" means the director of the Seattle-King  
21 County department of public health or his/her designated  
22 representative.

23 8. "Industrial solid wastes" means waste by-products from  
24 manufacturing operations such as scraps, trimmings, packing, and  
25 other discarded materials not otherwise designated as dangerous  
26 waste under Chapter 173-303 WAC.

27 9. "Liquid" means a substance that flows readily and assumes  
28 the form of its container but retains its independent volume.

29 10. "Mixed municipal solid waste" means waste consisting of  
30 garbage, solid waste generated by stores, offices, and other  
31 activities that do not actually turn out a product. and solid  
32 waste that normally originates in a residential environment.

1 E. Other wastes, such as industrial waste, semisolid, or  
2 liquid waste, and asbestos containing waste material, may be  
3 accepted at sites as designated and approved by the manager.

4 F. Acceptance of any suspect waste may be denied pending the  
5 health officer's approval.
