4 ORDINANCE NO. 8109

5 AN ORDINANCE amending the Local Service Area  
6 Maps of the Sewerage General Plan that  
designate areas within King County eligible to  
receive sewer service.

7 PREAMBLE:

8 On January 15, 1979, the King County council passed Ordinance  
4035, adopting the King County sewerage general plan.

9 The King County sewerage general plan includes Local Service  
10 Area maps showing where sewer service is allowed.

11 The King County sewerage general plan allows King County to  
initiate amendments to the Local Service Area.

12 Amendments to the Local Service Area maps should be made from  
13 time to time to rectify omissions and reflect actual service  
areas.

14 The resort area of King County known as Alpentel and  
15 Snoqualmie Pass currently receives sewer service but is not  
within a Local Service Area as required.

16 It is necessary for King County to initiate an amendment to  
17 the Local Service Area to correct this inappropriate omission  
from the adopted map.

18 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

19 SECTION 1. The Local Service Area Maps of the King County  
20 sewerage general plan are hereby amended to include the Alpentel  
21 and Snoqualmie Pass area described as follows:

22 That land within the east one-half of the west one-half, lying  
23 south of Interstate 90, in Section 4, Township 22, Range 11E,  
lying in King County; and

24 the west one-half of the southeast one-fourth of the southwest  
25 one-fourth of Section 33, Township 23, Range 11E; and

26 the northeast one-fourth of the southwest one-fourth of  
27 Section 33, Township 23, Range 11E, excluding the plat of  
Alpentel; and the plat of Alpentel lying in the west one-half  
of Section 33, Township 23, Range 11E; and

28 the lands recorded as the Alpenrose Condominium, the Valley  
29 Queen Mining Claim, the Marmot Mining Claim, the Mammoth 89  
Mining Claim eastery of the centerline of the Forest Service  
30 Road as recorded by auditors file 6146184,

1 the Goldener Alder Condominium and the Golderner Hirsh
