

ORDINANCE NO. 8116

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a  
portion of Forest Drive - V-1926  
Petitioner: Quartermaster Yacht Club and Others

1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a  
portion of Forest Drive, hereinafter described.

2. The division of building and land development has  
reviewed the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it  
would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the  
King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the  
vicinity of this proposed vacation.

3. The department of public works has notified the various  
utilities serving the area and has been advised that an easement  
was granted to Puget Power.

4. The vacation area is a portion of right-of-way dedicated  
to King County in the plat of Imnaha recorded in volume 16 of  
plats, page 10, records of King County, Washington. The  
department of public works found no evidence that the road has  
ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates  
that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition,  
improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified  
"C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.

5. The department of public works considers the subject  
right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and  
believes that the public would be benefited by the return of  
this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a  
hearing was held by the King County council on the  
15th day of June 1987.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the  
subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the  
best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said  
petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 15th day of  
June, 1987, hereby vacates and abandons the  
following described portion of Forest Drive :

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1 That portion of Forest Drive lying Westerly of a line 50  
2 feet Westerly of and parallel with the centerline of 103rd  
3 Avenue Southwest (Vashon Island Trunk Road 1040), Easterly  
4 of Block 10 and the Southerly production of the Easterly  
5 line thereof and North of the South 377.5 feet of Government  
6 Lot 3, Section 18, Township 22 North, Range 3 East, W.M.,  
7 King County, Washington; all in the Plat of Imnaha, as  
8 recorded in Volume 16 of Plats, page 10, Records of King  
9 County, Washington.

6 Contains an area of 2,750 Sq. Ft., or 0.063 Acres, M/L.
