ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE relating to an increase in the number of interview candidates for King County employment who would be reimbursed for reasonable and necessary travel expenses, amending Section 1 of Ordinance 6171 and K.C.C. 3.20.050.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6171, Section 1 and K.C.C. 3.20.040 are hereby amended as follows:

The personnel manager, based on the request of the appointing authority, may authorize in writing reimbursement for reasonable and necessary travel expenses to candidates four county employment for those positions at or above pay range 81, to travel to a designated place from their place of residence to be interviewed. Authorization for reimbursement for those positions paid at pay range 55 through 80 shall not be granted without prior approval of the county council's ((Operations, Police and Judiciary)) administration and justice committee. Such approval shall be secured prior to candidates being invited for interviews. Authorization for reimbursement will not be granted for positions paid at range 54 or below. Reimbursement shall be limited to the travel expenses of ((three)) five separate interviews for any one position within any twelve month period. Travel expense reimbursement shall be limited to the ((three)) five highest ranked candidates for the positoin. No one eligible candidate shall receive travel expense reimbursement for more than two separate interviews. Authorization of travel plans and procedures

1 for reimbursement shall be within budgetary constraints and  
2 consistent with the policies and provisions set forth in K.C.C.  
3 3.20 with respect to travel expenses for county employees and  
4 officials.
