

ORDINANCE 8189

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of East Marginal Way South

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The director of the department of public works has made an examination of East Marginal Way South along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of East Marginal Way South, said point begin South 31°58'32" East a distance of 1,717.09 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 10, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M. and designated as engineer's station 61+99.39 as surveyed by King County (Survey No. 10-23-4-6); thence North 11°19'05 West 807.89 feet; thence along a tangent curve to the left having a radius of 2,864.79 feet through a central angle of 4°19'12" for an arc distance of 216.00 feet; thence North 15°38'17" West 447.53 feet to the North line of said Section 10; thence continuing North 15°38'17" West 1,648.90 feet to the terminus point, said terminus point being North 4°56'35" East 1,570.28 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 10, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.

3,120' L.F. = 0.591 Mile

SECTION 3: King County council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
